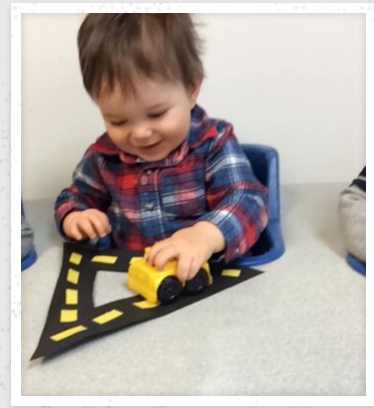
### Toddler Two
